The Chancellor's Guidelines – A Parochial Schedule

MATERIAL

<i>Stone</i>	As per guidelines	
<i>Finish</i>	Honed	allowed
	Part Polished	established practice
	All Polished	not allowed
<i>Colour</i>	White	Not allowed
	Light & Mid Grey	Allowed
	Dark Grey & Black	Established practise
	Brown/Red	Established practise in Barnetts Lane only as this is not near to the Church but it is not allowed in the Cremated Remains burial area.

Wooden Crosses as temporary markers are allowed for a maximum of six months only

<i>Shape</i>	As per guidelines – see reverse Otherwise Archdeacon
<i>Flower Receptacles</i>	Established Practise Preferably as part of the headstone, or standing on Headstone base.
<i>Dimensions</i>	As per guidelines
<i>Motifs and Tracery</i>	Must be deemed suitable to area Otherwise Archdeacon
<i>Flowers</i>	Fresh flowers, Christmas wreaths and Remembrance poppies are allowed also one small silk arrangement provided it is removed when past its best, (removal to be by the PCC if necessary).

Other items NOT ALLOWED include Astroturf and ornaments of any kind.
